I am so glad that I can rest in the fact that God knows what will be happening this coming year; and He will guide and direct. I do realize we are all in that same position of being unsure of the way we will be able to minister; but one thing is certain, the message still needs to be the same. Jesus Christ and His precious blood is the only way to have your sins forgiven and get to heaven. Methods of declaring the gospel might change but the true gospel will not change. Because we leave for Romania in a couple weeks we need to make sure any doctor visits or governmental paperwork is taken care of, as well as, being able to spend this Christmas with our family.
