Our online classes from July 2020 to March 12, 2021 went very well except **some of our students in NE India and Myanmar did not have internet access while others were able to find access for their phones!** Our faculty has done well and soon adopted to a new style of online teaching with notes shown the screen. **Most of the students used only their mobile phones.** It



was a challenge for me to teach Hebrew online but the Lord helped. Graduation is scheduled for July 21, God willing when we begin the new academic year. We trust we can open the Campus for regular classes again in July.

Our Church planters have been effectively used of our Lord as they preach and teach the Word of God and see lives changed. Many are hearing the Word and are convicted by the Holy Spirit but are afraid to trust our Lord for fear of family or the Priest. **Please pray for them!**

The **Central Govt. has required all Charitable Organizations in India to open new Bank Accounts in State Bank of India in New Delhi.** Contributions are now to be received only through their SBI account.

Our ongoing court case regarding the school property that we bought years ago, is scheduled for July 6, there has been little progress as the other four defendants have not turned up. Each time the court is sending summons to the other 4 defendants. **Please Pray that this will be resolved!**

Our Orphanage kids have all been with us through the pandemic and have done home schooling. Tim and Julie have been busy teaching them everyday.

We are so thankful to all Pastors and church families who pray for and support this work. The Lord bless and keep you.
