Hello Everyone,

Thank you for your support prayerfully and financially. We appreciate it very much! Without you we would not be able to be here ministering to the Romanian people.

Here is what is going on here in Romania. We praise the Lord things are loosening up with the covid restrictions. We no longer have to wear mask outside. They recently opened up indoor dining. We should not have any problems doing the Film Ministry this summer as long as the churches are willing to have us in. As of now, it cannot be over 50 people gathering outside. The Film Ministry will be mid June till the end of August. I started contacting churches and so far we are lined up till the end of July. Romania does not plan too far ahead. As Americans we're thinking we should have everything scheduled already, but that's not the way it works here in Romania. Please pray for God to open up doors where we should be and for hearts to be open to the Lord. Pray for God to use us and for us to have the helpers needed. We look forward to a good Film Ministry this summer.

Another thing happening is, we have an opportunity for ministry with the refugees. For a couple of weeks I was able to talk with them and do chalk drawings out on the streets. But now that has all changed and we can no longer continue ministering that way. But we are looking into going to the actual refugee camps. Please keep this in prayer for the Lord to open up the opportunity again to witness to the refugees.

In our last prayer letter I mentioned about the you tube videos I was doing. I am still doing them. However, we were not able to get the updated equipment from the offering church, yet. Partly because shipping things to Romania is even more difficult because of the pandemic. Thankfully I can still do the chalk drawing and videos with the equipment we have. Pray that the Lord would allow more people to see them and it would be of help.

I started translating a pamphlet called, "The Essence of Christianity". I am about halfway. I should be done by the end of the month. Pray for translating and printing to go well, and for many opportunities to give them out.

Lisa and the girls are doing well. The girls are actually done this school year, took a 3 week break and Abigail started up 12th grade on Monday. She turns 18 in December and Lord willing, will graduate the end of February 2022 and move back to the states. Our plan is to come back to the states March of 2022 for a couple months. During that time we will report to churches and help Abigail get set up with a job, car, and an apartment. We would appreciate prayer for everything to fall into place. We will be contacting supporting churches to schedule a time for us to update them when we are back. We are specifically looking at Michigan and the northeast. Please pray that things will get lined up for these months and for God's provision.

The ministry is going well here. While passing out tracts and talking to people, I can see where God is directing me to talk more with them about eternity. While talking to a man named, Gabriel, about spiritual matters, he said he has never really been concerned about eternity, but he is thinking about it more lately. He realizes he is getting older and needs to be more concerned about it. He admitted he does not have peace. I am thankful God brought that opportunity.

Marez, is another man I met. He is actually a refugee from Tanzania and he speaks English well. I was able to give him a New Testament in English. He is actually out of the country now. He is in Austria. Please pray that God will work in these men's heart and that they would come to be saved.

I went to Aiud last weekend and met with Ciprian and his church family. I did a chalk drawing on Saturday with the children and Sunday, I preached in his church. I also met with George Hollis, a former graduate from the Institute, about possibly doing the Film Ministry in his village.

I plan on going to Casa Dorca, the orphanage this weekend. It has been closed to visitors due to covid. It will be good to see the kids again.
